According to Norse mythology, the first man on Earth came from an ash tree. His wife, Embla, was created from an elm tree. The Icelandic name for ash is askr, which means spear. In ancient Greece the gods' spears and arrows were made of ash.

### Oiled ash internal doors

Ask your paint dealer for advice when buying oil. Bear in mind that there should not be too much solvent in the oil as it may smell too strong for indoor use. Oil the door with a cloth or sponge, then wipe off any excess. Repeat until the surface is saturated. If the wood fibres have lifted, rub first with fine sandpaper in the direction of the grain.
