



Brush-painted exterior doors

For touch-up painting/repainting: Brush the door with a soft brush and wash the door with warm water to remove dirt. Dull the surface with fine sandpaper (180 grit) in the direction of the grain. If small scratches appear from the sandpaper, sand with 320 paper to remove these. Remove the sanding dust with compressed air or a soft brush. Wipe with a soft rag. A single-component paint of your choice can now be applied.

Front doors with glass and/or panels

Check regularly that the silicone seal between the glass and glazing bead is intact. The silicone material is broken down by weather, which allows water to penetrate the structure and cause swelling and paint detachment. Use silicone suitable for glass (available at building supply stores) for maintenance. If the door leaf has a panel, check that the joint between the door leaf and the bead is intact. When maintenance is needed, use a silicone-free, paintable building sealant.
